## Conclusion of the study board

The study board has on its meeting on the above data decided that no immediate changes should be introduced into the curriculum. Comments from the students indicating 1) a wish for more electronics; 2) a need to streamline programming courses; 3) remove repetitions from Health Science related courses have been taken into account in the

recent revision of the study regulations. The new study regulations are valid from September 2021 and it can take a year or two while the introduced changes will give a positive effect. Additionally, the students express regret that the study language was changed to Danish: the students write that the presence of international students was giving a positive boost to the study environment.
