#### 8. 2021 intake figures

CBM presented the intake figures regarding September 2021. See the attached document. The figures for the intake on the bachelor programs looks better compared to 2020. The masters degree figures for Medialogy are quite high. It is because of students with legal right. The other masters have very stable figures every year. There is now a limit of 30 to those programs.

### Students in risk of dropping out

The Study Board was presented with the March 2021 figures regarding students in risk of dropping out. The secretariat is working on letters to the students. Some of the students have already made individual plans with the secretariat. Other master students have changed their semesters and chosen thesis work in the fall 2020 and internship in spring 2021. This is of course due to the Covid-19 situation. We expect to send out 10 mails to students in red and 10 mails to students in yellow.
