- IAS PBL offers to connect you with an IAS PBL researcher to provide consultancy on processes related to educational or PBL-related development.
- You will be connected to an IAS PBL researcher within your main area during the process.
- This offer is suitable for processes spanning a few weeks or longer. Examples include comprehensive curriculum revisions related to PBL, master's programme reform, interdisciplinary collaboration between students or the development of educational practices.
- In collaboration with the IAS PBL researcher, you will determine how the process will be organised and decide which parts of the process you wish for the IAS PBL researcher to be involved in.






EXAMPLE: SHORT-TERM PROCESS
